REVISION TO THE LOWER DELAWARE WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT
PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **APR 24 1997**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Lower Delaware Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision corrects the Cohansey River Basin Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) with regard to the Devereux Foundation site located at Block 52, Lot 22.07 in Hopewell Township, Cumberland County. The Devereux Foundation site is located on the Future Sewer Facilities Map within an area designated as future sewer service area of the Cohansey River Basin Sewage Treatment Plant (STP). However, this site is also identified on this same map and in the WMP narrative as an existing and future subsurface wastewater disposal facility with planning flows greater than 2,000 gallons per day but less than 20,000 gallons per day with no plans for the wastewater treatment system's abandonment. This revision identifies the abandonment of this on-site wastewater treatment system for connection to the Cohansey River Basin STP.
