AMENDMENT TO THE LOWER RARITAN/MIDDLESEX COUNTY WATER  
QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on February 1, 1994, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Lower Raritan/Middlesex County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment proposal was submitted by Van Note-Harvey Associates on behalf of the Township of Plainsboro. This amendment to the Plainsboro Township Wastewater Management Plan includes Block 6, Lots 8.03 and 14.01 and Block 6.24, Lot 21 into the sewer service area of the Princeton Meadows Utility Company and removes said lots from the Middlesex County Utilities Authority sewer service area. These tracts of land are zoned R-300 and the intended use of these lands are for public facilities.

This amendment represents only one part of the permit process and other issues will be addressed prior to final permit issuance. Additional issues which were not reviewed in conjunction with this amendment but which may need to be addressed may include, but are not limited to, the following: antidegradation; effluent limitations; water quality analysis; exact locations and designs of future treatment works (pump stations, interceptors, sewers, outfalls, wastewater treatment plants); and development in wetlands, flood prone areas, designated Wild and Scenic River areas, or other environmentally sensitive areas which are subject to regulation under federal or State statutes or rules.
