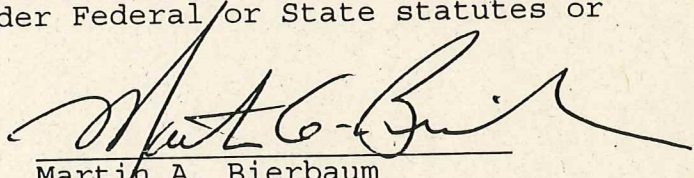
AMENDMENT TO THE LOWER RARITAN/MIDDLESEX COUNTY WATER
QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on _____, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Lower Raritan/Middlesex County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department). This amendment updates the Plainsboro Township Wastewater Management Plan to expand the Stony Brook Regional Sewerage Authority River Road Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) sewer service area in Plainsboro Township to include the existing Middle School (Block 11, Lot 29.03) and Upper Elementary School (Block 11, Lot 29.05) and the proposed high school (portion of Block 14, Lot 19). The two existing schools are presently served by the Princeton Meadows Utilities Company (PMUC) STP and will be removed from the PMUC sewer service area. The proposed high school property will be removed from the Middlesex County Utilities Authority sewer service area.

This amendment represents only one part of the permit process and other issues will be addressed prior to final permit issuance. Additional issues which were not reviewed in conjunction with this amendment but which may need to be addressed may include, but are not limited to, the following: antidegradation; effluent limitations; water quality analysis; exact locations and designs of future treatment works (pump stations, interceptors, sewers, outfalls, wastewater treatment plants); and development in wetlands, flood prone areas, designated Wild and Scenic River areas, or other environmentally sensitive areas which are subject to regulation under Federal or State statutes or rules.
