REVISION TO THE NORTHEAST AND LOWER/RARITAN MIDDLESEX
COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLANS

TAKE NOTICE that on JAN 20 1998, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Northeast and Lower Raritan/Middlesex County Water Quality Management Plans was adopted by the Department. This revision removes certain properties located in Scotch Plains Township, Union County, from the Rahway Valley Sewerage Authority (RVSA) sewer service area and transfers them to the Middlesex County Utilities Authority (MCUA) sewer service area. Topography at the properties will not allow the wastewater to be conveyed via gravity to the RVSA Sewage Treatment Plant (STP), which discharges to the Arthur Kill. Gravity connections can be made from the sites into the sewerage systems which convey wastewater to the MCUA STP, which discharges to the Raritan Bay and Raritan River. The properties to be transferred are: Block 15801, Lots 4, 5, 9, and 10 (Woodland Estates Associates/Hovnanian); Block 16402, Lot 1 (Kings Court/Mansa, Inc.); Block 16401, Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9; Block 16301, Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11; Block 16302, Lots 5 and 6. The properties are located along the City of Plainfield municipal border and Woodland Avenue and along the Township of Edison municipal border, King Street and Webb Street. The total area to be transferred is approximately 16.94 acres. No expansion of the MCUA STP is proposed as part of the transfer.
