



AMENDMENT TO THE MERCER COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN


Public Notice

Take notice that on **JUN 30 1994**, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Mercer County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment will change the Stony Brook Regional Sewerage Authority's (SBRSA) sewer service area in two areas of Princeton Township: 1) flows in the North Ridge Area of Princeton Township presently served by the Montgomery Stage II Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) will be re-directed to the SBRSA STP; and 2) realignment of the SBRSA sewer service area within the lands of the Institute of Advanced Study (identified as Block S-12.04, Lots 110, 134, and 136, zoning district R-HF-W sub-area A on the August 1993, Princeton & Princeton Borough Sewer Service Area Delineation Map 4) to comply with recent zoning changes. Additionally, the amendment updates the Princeton Township/Princeton Borough Wastewater Management Plan regarding abandonment of the Pretty Brook STP and its conversion to a pump station.

This amendment represents only one part of the permit process and other issues will be addressed prior to final permit issuance. Additional issues which were not reviewed in conjunction with this amendment but which may need to be addressed may include, but are not limited to, the following: antidegradation; effluent limitations; water quality analysis; exact locations and designs of future treatment works (pump stations, interceptors, sewers, outfalls, wastewater treatment plants); and development in wetlands, flood prone areas, designated Wild and Scenic River areas, or other environmentally sensitive areas which are subject to regulation under federal or State statutes or rules.
