AMENDMENT TO THE MONMOUTH COUNTY WATER QUALITY
MANAGEMENT PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on DEC 15 1994, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Monmouth County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment proposal was submitted on behalf of the Western Monmouth Utilities Authority (WMUA). The amendment updates the WMUA and Bayshore Regional Sewerage Authority (BRSA) Wastewater Management Plans (WMPs) in Marlboro Township. The WMPs identify a sewer service area expansion to the BRSA Union Beach Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) to serve the proposed Woodbury Oaks single family home development to be located at Block 120, Lots 32.02, 64 and 67 in the Morganville section of Marlboro Township. The projected wastewater planning flow from this site is 30,000 gallons per day. This brings the projected wastewater planning flow need of the BRSA Union Beach STP for Marlboro Township to 917,000 gallons per day.

This amendment represents only one part of the permit process and other issues will be addressed prior to final permit issuance. Additional issues which were not reviewed in conjunction with this amendment but which may need to be addressed may include, but are not limited to, the following: antidegradation; effluent limitations; water quality analysis; exact locations and designs of future treatment works (pump stations, interceptors, sewers, outfalls, wastewater treatment plants); and development in wetlands, flood prone areas, designated Wild and Scenic River areas, or other environmentally sensitive areas which are subject to regulation under federal or State statutes or rules.
