REVISION TO THE MONMOUTH COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT
PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on FEB 06 1996, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Monmouth County Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision updates the Colts Neck Township Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) for the proposed Colts Neck High School which was previously known as the Freehold Regional High School. The WMP identified the projected population of this school as 1,600 students and 200 staff. This population was to be served by a Cycle-Let system with an unspecified design capacity and a 5,500 gallons per day (gpd) wastewater discharge to subsurface disposal beds.

A draft New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit has now been issued for this facility. The draft permit continues to identify the wastewater treatment system for this facility as a recycling system with discharge to subsurface disposal beds. However, under current Department standards and based on a projected student population of only 1,300, the proposed design capacity of this facility is 32,500 gpd. Based on an alternate design proposal for Cycle-Let systems which is acceptable to the Department's Bureau of Operational Ground Water Permits, the actual design capacity for this facility will be approximately 13,000 gpd with a 6,000 gpd discharge to the subsurface system. In addition, a correction to the WMP narrative was made to identify a portion of Block 43, Lot 2, as part of the school site. This property is shown on the adopted Colts Neck Township WMP sewer service area map, but was inadvertently not identified within the narrative. Also, as part of this revision, a facility table for Colts Neck High School was added to the WMP document.
