

REVISION TO THE MONMOUTH COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **DEC 21 2000**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Monmouth County Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection. This revision expands the sewer service area of the Bayshore Regional Sewerage Authority to include Lot 7, Block 170 of Marlboro Township. The subject 10.73 acre parcel is the proposed site of an Early Childhood Learning Center to be built by the Marlboro Township Board of Education. The proposed facility will have a projected wastewater planning flow of 3,000 gallons per day. Wastewater will be transmitted from the proposed facility by a pump station and associated force main designed to accommodate the projected flow. The pump station and force main will be owned, operated and maintained by the Marlboro Township Board of Education and will be for the exclusive use of the proposed Early Childhood Learning Center. This revision also modifies the Bayshore Regional Sewerage Authority Wastewater Management Plan and the Western Monmouth Utilities Authority Wastewater Management Plan. Due to the scope of this revision it is not subject to the alternative analyses required by Executive Order 109.
