REVISION TO THE MONMOUTH COUNTY WATER QUALITY
MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on OCT 10 2002, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Monmouth County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department). This revision expands the Two Rivers Reclamation Authority sewer service area to include a 10.7-acre property designated as Block 123, Lots 14 and 18.01 in the Borough of Tinton Falls, Monmouth County. Wastewater flows of 6,600 gallons per day (gpd) are projected based on 300 gpd for each of 22 single-family detached 3-bedroom homes. This revision has been reviewed in accordance with Executive Order No. 109(2000) and N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.18. Due to the scope of this revision, it is not subject to the alternatives analyses under that Executive Order and rule provision.
