REVISION TO THE MONMOUTH COUNTY WATER QUALITY  
MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **OCT 07 2004**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Monmouth County Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision updates the Monmouth County WQMP and the Township of Middletown Sewerage Authority Wastewater Management Plan to identify the existing and currently NJPDES-permitted Oil and Hazardous Materials Simulations Test Tank (OHMSETT) wastewater treatment facility in Middletown Township, Monmouth County. The facility, with permit NJ0005762, has a 2.6 million gallon test tank that is periodically (no more than twice per year) discharged into Sandy Hook Bay. This revision has been reviewed in accordance with Executive Order No. 109 (2000) and N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.18. Due to the scope of this revision, it is not subject to the alternatives analyses under that Executive Order and rule provision.
