

REVISION TO THE MONMOUTH COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT
PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **AUG 6 2007** pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Monmouth County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision also modifies the Upper Freehold Wastewater Management Plan (WMP). This revision changes a 121.71 acre portion of the previously approved Commerce Park Planned Development site from commercial uses to use as a proposed Middle and Elementary School site. The Commerce Park site consists of Block 44, Lots 2 and 13 and Block 45, Lot 1 located in Upper Freehold Township, Monmouth County. The WMP currently designates this site as a sewer service area for a proposed 126,760 Gallon per Day (gpd) Discharge to Groundwater wastewater treatment plant to serve commercial, non-industrial uses. The proposed Middle and Elementary Schools and treatment plant will be located on Block 44, Lot 13. The proposed project site is located north of Yardville-Allentown Road, east of the border between Upper Freehold and Hamilton Townships, west of Block 44, Lot 2, and south of Potts Road.
