AMENDMENT TO THE NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on **MAY 17 1993**, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment updates the Wanaque Borough Wastewater Management Plan (WMP). The amendment allows for expansion of the sewer service area of the Wanaque Valley Regional Sewerage Authority (WVRS) Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) to serve (1) existing and proposed development within the "Bird Sanctuary" area of Wanaque Borough (94 homes) and (2) the Elks Camp Moore (140 campers and counselors). The total projected wastewater flow to the WVRS STP as specified in the Wanaque Borough WMP is amended to 1.522 million gallons per day.
