

REVISION TO THE NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **MAR 21 1997**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision updates the Oakland Borough Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) with regard to the number and type of units proposed to be served by the **Riverbend** Wastewater Treatment Plant (WTP). This WTP is proposed to discharge 113,700 gallons per day to the Ramapo River under New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit No. NJ0080811. No change in the projected wastewater flow or sewer service area is proposed as part of this revision. However, the total number of units is increased from 394 to 400 (399 proposed and 1 existing) to provide for 85 two bedroom units (townhouses and single family homes), 285 three bedroom units (townhouses and single family homes), and 30 four bedroom single family home units. A recreation building/clubhouse is also proposed but will not provide any additional wastewater flow. This information is consistent with that provided in Treatment Works Approval application No. 97-0818-4.
