REVISION TO THE NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Take notice that on **MAR 05 1999**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department.

This revision addresses the Harding Township School at Block 49, Lot 9 in Harding Township, Morris County. The Harding Township Board of Education will include a new gymnasium and additional classrooms. The functional capacity after expansion will be 550 students. The two existing on-site ground water disposal systems, with a projected flow of 5,205 gallons per day (gpd), will be abandoned and replaced with a new on-site ground water disposal system with a projected wastewater flow of 8,250 gpd (based on the Department's flow criterion of 15 gpd/student for a school with a cafeteria). The school is located within the watershed of Great Brook which is classified as Category 1 (C1) within the Great Swamp National Wildlife Refuge.
