

REVISION TO THE NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **MAY 10 1999**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection. The revision allows for expansion of the sewer service area to the Morristown Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) which discharges to the Whippany River. The sewer service area is expanded to include Lots 6, 7, 8, 9 and 13, Block 10104 in Morris Township. Toyota of Morristown, located on Lot 6, Block 10104, has experienced failure of its septic system and is therefore proposing to construct a sewer line approximately 893 feet to the sewer on Hanover Avenue. Lots 7, 8, 9, and 13 are included in the service area expansion because they are located along or near the proposed sewer easement. The expanded service area consists of a total of 15 acres and includes a projected flow of approximately 6,000 gallons per day. No expansion of the Morristown STP is needed or proposed as part of this revision.
