

REVISION TO THE NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on APR 30 2003, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision provides for the transfer of sewer service area and flows from the Rahway Valley Sewerage Authority to the Joint Meeting of Essex & Union Counties. The currently developed property consists of 3,649 square feet of existing office space and an industrial warehouse that has four employees. The property is located on Block 1, Lot 10 in the Borough of Kenilworth. The office space will generate 365 gallons per day (gpd) and the warehouse will generate 25 gallons/day/employee for 100 gpd. The wastewater generated by the 505 North Michigan Avenue site will total 465 gpd. This revision has been reviewed in accordance with Executive Order No. 109 (2000) and N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.18. Due to the scope of this revision, it is not subject to the alternative analysis under that Executive Order and rule provision. This revision modifies both the Rahway Valley Sewerage Authority Wastewater Management Plan and the Joint Meeting of Essex & Union Counties Wastewater Management Plan.
