

REVISION TO THE NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Take Notice that on 6/5/03, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department). This revision will note in the Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (NBCUA) Wastewater Management Plan (WMP), the flow of the existing Franklin Square Shopping Center, New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) permit NJ0082899, which is located in Franklin Lakes Borough. This facility consists of a 20,000 square foot shopping center that includes three restaurants, a gym, a veterinary hospital, a dry-cleaner, a nail salon and a convenience store. The flow from this shopping center discharges into an on-site subsurface disposal system. The permit, that is to be renewed, will reauthorize the discharge of 3,500 gallons per day (gpd) to the disposal system. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5(b)1, this revision modifies Table V-3 for Industrial Dischargers in the Northeast WQMP by citing the permitted flow.
