

REVISION TO THE NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT
PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on OCT 07 2004, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision will note in the Pequannock, Lincoln Park, Fairfield Sewerage Authority Wastewater Management Plan (WMP), the existing Two Bridges Sewerage Authority Sewage Treatment Plant, New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) permitted discharge to groundwater (NJ0079651), which is located in Lincoln Park. This facility processes sewage sludge generated at the facility, as well as sludge from outside sources. The residue resulting from incineration is pumped as slurry to two earth lined infiltration/percolation lagoons. Water from the slurry is reduced by evaporation and infiltration and the ash is used as fill material offsite. The flow which infiltrates from the lagoons discharges into Wisconsin stratified glacial drift underlain by the Triassic Brunswick formation. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5(b)1, this revision modifies Table V-3 for Industrial Dischargers in the Northeast WQMP by citing this permitted discharge.
