


REVISION TO THE LOWER RARITAN/MIDDLESEX COUNTY AND  
NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on January 23, 2007, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Lower Raritan/Middlesex County Water Quality Management Plan and the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision also modifies the Lower Raritan/Middlesex County Wastewater Management Plan. This revision provides for the transfer of sewer service area and flows for the Hidden Meadows property located on Block 7502, Lots 10, 17 & 19 in the Township of Scotch Plains, from the Rahway Valley Sewerage Authority to the Middlesex County Utilities Authority. Presently the property consists of one single family home and is proposing five single family homes. The wastewater generated by Hidden Meadows that is to be transferred from Rahway Valley Sewerage Authority to the Middlesex County Utilities Authority will generate a total of 1,800 gallons per day (gpd). The Hidden Meadows project site qualifies as a revision under N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5 (b) 4ii as the project is a transfer of sewer service area from one domestic treatment works to another.
