

REVISION TO THE NORTHEAST WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT
PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on JUN 15 2007, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision for the Transcontinental Gas Corporation Station 240 located at Block: 137 Lots: 1-20 in Carlstadt Borough, Bergen County is for the relocation of their discharge pipe outfall. The outfall is relocating from an unnamed tributary of the Hackensack River at Latitude N40° 48' 34" and longitude W74° 03' 06" to the main body of the Hackensack River which is classified as SE2 water bodies. This project qualifies as a revision under N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5.
