

REVISION TO THE Northeast WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on ~~NOV 20 2013~~, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision updates the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan to identify the existing discharge of 13,650 gallon per day to ground water which served Mount Saint Francis property. It is to be redeveloped to the American Addiction Centers (AAC) that is located on Block 1100, Lots 1 and 1.01 in Ringwood Borough, Passaic County, New Jersey. The facility, with permit number NJG0211397 has an estimated daily flow of 11,550 gallons per day.

This revision has been reviewed in accordance with Executive Order No. 109 (2000) and N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.18. Due to the scope of this revision, it is not subject to the alternative analysis under that Executive Order and rule provision. This revision modifies the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan.
