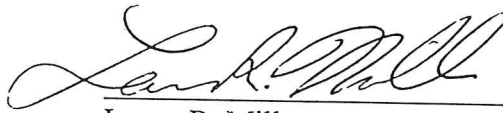

AMENDMENT TO THE OCEAN COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on AUG 02 1999, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Ocean County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection. This amendment provides for a new discharge to ground water to serve the Pine Barrens Golf Club located on Block 32.01, Lot 59.01 in Jackson Township. The site of the golf club is approximately 430 acres. The property is partly in and partly outside of the sewer service area of the Ocean County Utilities Authority's Central Water Pollution Control Facility. The projected wastewater flow from the golf club-related facilities is 8,364 gallons per day (gpd) based on the following breakdown: maintenance building, 150 gpd; superintendent's residence, 650 gpd; comfort station #1, 732 gpd; comfort station #2, 732 gpd; and main clubhouse, 6,100 gpd. This amendment also modifies the Jackson Township Wastewater Management Plan.

This amendment represents only one part of the permit process and other issues will be addressed prior to final permit issuance. Additional issues which were not reviewed in conjunction with this amendment but which may need to be addressed may include, but are not limited to, the following: antidegradation; effluent limitations; water quality analysis; exact locations and designs of future treatment works (pump stations, interceptors, sewers, outfalls, wastewater treatment plants); and development in wetlands, flood prone areas, designated Wild and Scenic River areas, or other environmentally sensitive areas which are subject to regulation under Federal or State statutes or rules.
