AMENDMENT TO THE TRI-COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT
PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on August 26, 1986 pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the "Water Quality Management Planning and Implementation Process" Regulations (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment will allow the Evesham Municipal Utilities Authority (MUA) to expand the Woodstream Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) from 1.25 million gallons per day (mgd) to 1.70 mgd. The sewer service area delineation line between the Woodstream and Elmwood plants in Evesham will be adjusted to accurately reflect existing conditions. The amendment also provides for the expansion of the Kings' Grant STP to an ultimate capacity of 1.05 mgd and to allow sewer service to the Marlton Lakes area of the Township from either the Elmwood STP or the construction of a STEP system, whichever is most feasible. Evesham MUA will serve as co-permittee for the expansion of the King's Grant STP.
