
AMENDMENT TO THE TRI-COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT  
PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on October 7, 1986 pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the "Water Quality Management Planning and Implementation Process" Regulations (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment will allow a new leachate treatment facility to be constructed as part of the Burlington County Solid Waste Management Facilities Complex in Florence and Mansfield Townships. The leachate treatment facility will treat leachate from the Burlington County landfill and the Florence Land Recontouring, Inc. landfill. The leachate treatment facility will also handle sanitary waste from all buildings associated with the Burlington County landfill, and leachate from the County composting facility. The leachate treatment facility will have a capacity of approximately 28,000 gallons per day. The creation of 2.3 acres of wetlands on approved sites adjacent to existing wetlands, as mitigation for encroachment of 2.3 acres of wetlands due to the construction of this project. This amendment will also designate the Burlington County Board of Chosen Freeholders as the Wastewater Management Agency for this facility.
