
AMENDMENT TO THE TRI-COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on July 6, 1988 pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the "Water Quality Management Planning and Implementation Process" Regulations (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment will allow the expansion of the sewer service area of the Mount Laurel Township Municipal Utilities Authority (MUA) to include a proposed residential development on Block 508, Lot 4, Mount Laurel Township. There are wetlands on the project site. This amendment will also allow the filling of 0.25 acres of wetlands for minor road crossings for the project. All remaining wetlands on the project site have been identified as a conservation easement which has been recorded with the Burlington County Clerk.
