
AMENDMENT TO THE TRI-COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on **SEP 25 1991**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq. and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Tri-County Water Quality Management (WQM) Plan was adopted by the Department. The amendment was proposed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for Fort Dix and McGuire Air Force Base. This amendment identifies a new 4.6 million gallons per day tertiary wastewater treatment facility to replace the two existing wastewater treatment facilities currently servicing Fort Dix and McGuire Air Force Base. A proposed land application site for this new facility contains wetlands, however, wetlands issues will be addressed during the Pinelands Commission approval process.
