





AMENDMENT TO THE TRI-COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Public Notice

Take notice that on **JUL 22 1993**, pursuant to the provisions of the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules (N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4), an amendment to the Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This amendment updates the Medford Township Wastewater Management Plan (WMP). The amendment expands the sewer service area of the Medford Township Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) to include a portion of the Township known as the Hessert Tract (Block 905, Lot 13) and adjacent existing subdivisions (Block 1001, 1002, 1101, 1102) which are experiencing septic problems, both situated in a Rural Suburban Development zone. An existing restaurant (Block 905, Lot 14), which already is connected to the public sewer system, also lies within the area added to the sewer service area designation. The proposed wastewater flow from the added sites is 13,260 gallons per day. In addition, the WMP update includes a minor revision to Block 2701.20, Lots 9 and part of 10. This revision corrects the service area designation from proposed septic service area to proposed sewer service area. This site presently lies within the sewer service area boundary, of the Medford Township STP, but was improperly labeled as septic service area. Wetlands issues will be addressed by the Pinelands Commission during their review and approval process.
