REVISION TO THE TRI-COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **DEC 04 2001**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision was requested on behalf of the Township of Moorestown. Moorestown Township will transfer a 3-acre property (Block 7400, Lot 1.01) from their sewer service area (SSA) to the Mount Holly Municipal Utilities Authority (MHMUA) SSA. This property is located directly across the street from Laurel Creek Subdivision (which is sewerred by MHMUA). There will be no social hall, public meeting room or administrative office planned at this satellite public safety facility, thus, the flow will be below 2,000 gpd. Although within the Moorestown approved sewer service area presently, this building would be thousands of feet away from the nearest receiving sewer in the Moorestown system. Thus, having MHMUA service this small parcel would save Moorestown Township on infrastructure costs.
