



REVISION TO THE TRI-COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **JAN 27 2003**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision modifies the Mount Laurel Township Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) and the Evesham Township WMP with regard to six new homes (Block 15, Lot 10) and eight existing homes (Block 15, Lot 11.10-11.14 and Block 11.51 Lot 9,11,12) in Evesham Township, Burlington County. These properties are within the sewer service area of the EMUA Elmwood Road Wastewater Treatment Plant, however the EMUA's collection system does not extend to the area of the proposed connection and extension of lines is not feasible. The revision allows these fourteen, single family homes within Evesham Township to discharge wastewater to the Hartford Road WPCF in Mount Laurel Township.
