


REVISION TO THE TRI-COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **APR 27 2006**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58-11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Tri-County Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision corrects the Tri-County WQMP pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5(b)1, to include an existing industrial facility known as Hoeganaes Corporation. This facility has discharged to the Delaware River under NJPDES permit number NJ0004375 for more than 25 years. This discharge consists of stormwater, non-contact cooling water, groundwater, and up to 16,700 gallons of process wastewater on an intermittent basis (maximum of once per week). The total current long-term average discharge amount is 30,000 gallons per day, with no permitted flow limitation in the NJPDES permit. This facility is located in Cinnaminson Township, Burlington County at 1001 Taylors Lane.
