Amendment Being Proposed

This amendment adopts a Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) for Blairstown Township, Warren County. The WMP identifies a proposed Lambert Road wastewater treatment facility. The Blair Academy Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) and the North Warren High School STP will be abandoned and incorporated into the sewer service area of the proposed Lambert Road wastewater treatment facility. The WMP also designates an on-site groundwater disposal area. The remainder of the Township will utilize individual subsurface sewage disposal systems.
