




REVISION TO THE UPPER DELAWARE WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN,  
THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON AND THE BOROUGH OF WASHINGTON,  
WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT PLANS

TAKE NOTICE that on NOV 19 2004, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Upper Delaware Water Quality Management Plan was adopted by the Department. This revision updates the Township of Washington, Warren County (Township) and the Borough of Washington, Warren County (Borough) Wastewater Management Plans to add the existing Port Colden Mall, located in the Township on Block 40, Lot 87.01 (approximately 4.6 acres), to the sewer service area that is served by the Borough's Sewage Treatment Plant, in accordance with a Administrative Consent Order that was executed on October 4, 2004 between the Department and Heights Equities, Inc., owner of the Port Colden Mall. The existing mall has a failed on-site package treatment plant that will be abandoned upon connection of the mall (projected wastewater flow of 4000 gallons per day) to the Borough's sewage collection system.
