


REVISION TO THE UPPER DELAWARE WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **FEB 11 2009**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Upper Delaware Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision grants the Lopatcong Township, Warren County, with alternative assignment of wastewater management plan (WMP) responsibility. In a letter dated June 30, 2008, the Warren County Board of Chosen Freeholders notified the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection that the County does not intend to submit a WMP. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-5.13(c), Lopatcong Township has requested WMP responsibility for the Township.
