

REVISION TO THE NORTHEAST AND UPPER RARITAN WATER QUALITY
MANAGEMENT PLANS

TAKE NOTICE that on **SEP 29 1997**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58:11A-1 et seq., and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Northeast and Upper Raritan Water Quality Management Plans (WQMPs) was adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department). The revision updates the Township of Bernards Sewerage Authority Wastewater Management Plan (WMP) to identify the United States Golf Association (USGA) Headquarters Office and Testing Facility, located in Bernards Township, Somerset County, as within a "service area for wastewater facilities with planning flows of less than 20,000 gallons per day (gpd) which discharge to ground water". The USGA facility currently has approximately 155 employees and 53 visitors per day which generate an estimated 2,600 gpd. This flow is treated by an existing on-site ground water disposal system which discharges within the Raritan River Basin portion of the site. The USGA facility is proposed to be expanded by approximately 44,827 square feet which would allow for a total of 287 employees and 238 visitors per day. The on-site ground water disposal system is proposed to be expanded to serve the additional employees and visitors with the total projected wastewater flow remaining under 20,000 gpd (currently projected to be 5,500 gpd).
