

REVISION TO THE UPPER RARITAN WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

TAKE NOTICE that on **SEP 14 2010**, pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Upper Raritan Water Quality Management Plan (WQMP) was adopted by the Department. This revision expands the Sewer Service Area (SSA) of the Washington Township Municipal Utility Authority's Long Valley Wastewater Treatment Plant (WTP) (NJ0109061) to include only the existing 11 single family homes at: 56 Bartley Road (Block 28/ Lot 11.01), 64 Bartley Road (Block 28/ Lot 11.03), 72 Bartley Road (Block 28/ Lot 13), 78 Bartley Road (Block 28/ Lot 12), 107 Bartley Road (Block 29/ Lot 23), 120 Road Bartley Road (Block 28/ Lot 66), 131 Bartley Road (Block 18/ Lot 30 [New Block 18.01, Lot 25]), 152 Bartley Road (Block 15/ Lot 19.03), 157 Bartley Road (Block 18/ Lot 23), 186 Bartley Road (Block 15/ Lot 17.01) and 249 Bartley Road (Block 18/ Lot 1.07). This will generate an additional 3,300 gallons per day (gpd) to the Long Valley WTP. Additionally, Schooley's Mountain WTP (NJ0023493) will expand its SSA to include a single family home each at 38 Rock Road (Block 23/ Lot 15.01) and 86 Springtown Road (Block 23/ Lot 7.01) which will generate 600 gpd to the Schooley's Mountain WTP.

The Washington Township Board of Health has provided documentation that the above mentioned properties currently have failing septic systems and it is not feasible to repair or replace the existing individual subsurface sewage disposal systems, so the Department is processing this revision under N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5 (b) 4 ix.
