
REVISION TO THE TRI-COUNTY AND UPPER RARITAN WATER QUALITY
MANAGEMENT PLANS

TAKE NOTICE that on **JUL 19 2012** pursuant to the provisions of the Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A.58:11A-1 et seq, and the Statewide Water Quality Management Planning rules, N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5, a revision to the Tri-County and Upper Raritan Water Quality Management (WQM) Plans was adopted by the Department. This revision updates the digital sewer service area (SSA) mapping to correct minor errors within the digitized SSA mapping consistent with the appropriate adopted Areawide Water Quality Management Plans (WQMP) and Wastewater Management Plans (WMP). As provided under N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.5(b)1, this revision is adopted to correct or clarify information in the Areawide WQMP's.

Within the Tri-County WQM Planning Area in Deptford Township, Gloucester County a correction has been made to expand the Gloucester County Utility Authority Sewage Treatment Plant (NJ0024686) SSA to include the following parcels, Block 389 Lot 1, Block 390 Lot 5, Block 391 Lot 1, Block 392 Lots 2, 3, & 4, Block 393 Lot 1, Block 395 Lots 2, 3, 26, 28-31 and Block 398 Lots 14 - 16, 17.01, 18, 35 & 36. These parcels were issued Treatment Works Approval for sanitary sewer extensions to serve the Fernmoor Properties and Deptford Walk residential developments.

Within the Upper Raritan WQM Planning Area in Chester Township, Somerset County a correction has been made to expand the Environmental Disposal Corporation Wastewater Treatment Plant (NJ0033995) to include the Gill St. Bernard's School located on Block 5 Lot 1 as identified in an amendment to the Upper Raritan WQM Plan that was adopted August 18, 1994.

Corrections to the SSA attribute table have been made to update the necessary fields to indicate the appropriate WMP plans, facilities, planning agencies, NJPDES permit number and discharge flow.
