



BRIGADIER GENERAL ARTHUR C. ROSCOE, JR.



Brig. Gen. Arthur C. Roscoe, Jr., is the Deputy Adjutant General of New Jersey. He is the principal advisor to The Adjutant General and Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Military Affairs on all matters concerning military readiness, mobilizations, homeland security, defense support to civil authorities, human resources, logistics, training, and financial management. The duties include the supervision and management of the Department's 3,200 full-time State and Federal employees, and more than 30 armories and associated properties.

Brig. Gen. Roscoe's military career began in April 1991 when he enlisted with the United States Army Reserve and served with the 439th Engineer Company at Fort Dix, New Jersey. In 1992, he transferred to the 1st Battalion, 112th Field Artillery Regiment, New Jersey Army National Guard, at the National Guard Armory in Cherry Hill, New Jersey. On August 17, 1995, he was commissioned as a second lieutenant through the Officer Candidate School at the New Jersey Military Academy in Sea Girt, New Jersey. His first assignment was as a fire direction officer with A Battery, 1st Battalion, 112th Field Artillery Regiment, New Jersey Army National Guard.

Brig. Gen. Roscoe has served in a variety of leadership positions including fire direction officer; battery executive officer; platoon leader; intelligence and training officer; director of support with the Joint Training and Training Development Center; deputy chief of staff for Logistics for Joint Force Headquarters – New Jersey; executive officer, 119th Combat Sustainment Support Battalion; Commander, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 250th Brigade Support Battalion; Executive Officer, Headquarters, 42nd Regional Support Group; State Partnership Program Oversight Officer with the Strategy, Policy, Plans and International Affairs Directorate, National Guard Bureau, Arlington, Virginia; Commander, 42nd Regional Support Group and Chief of Staff, New Jersey Army National Guard. His previous assignment was Director of the Joint Staff, Joint Force Headquarters.
