This matter having been opened to the Office of Consumer Finance within the Division of Banking of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance ("Department") upon information that Telmate, LLC ("Telmate"), an entity which provides services pursuant to the New Jersey Money Transmitters Act (The "Act"), N.J.S.A. 17:15C-1 et seq. (the "Act"), may have violated certain provisions of the Act; and

WHEREAS IT APPEARS that Telmate may have violated the following:

1. N.J.S.A. 17:15C-4. Conduct of money transmission business; license required (a)

- "No person, other than a person exempt from the provisions of this act pursuant
to 3, shall engage in the business of money transmission without a license as
provided in this act."

Notably, Telmate has been engaged in the money transmission business in New Jersey since March 2010 without proper licensure. Telmate has since indicated that it is in the process of obtaining the proper license pursuant to the Act.

AND WHEREAS, in the event that the Commissioner issued an administrative Order to Show Cause to Telmate addressing the above-referenced apparent violations, Telmate would be entitled to request a hearing of the matter as a contested case in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, N.J.S.A. 52:14B-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS Telmate understands these rights and has voluntarily waived the right to a hearing on the matters addressed in this Consent Order; and

WHEREAS, without making any admission of liability with respect to any of the apparent violations cited in this Consent Order, Telmate has agreed for purposes of settlement to undertake the following actions: Obtain licensure pursuant to the Act and ensure compliance with it and all the corresponding regulations during and after the application process. Telmate will immediately notify the Enforcement Bureau once the subject license has been approved or denied to determine if further action is needed.

WHEREAS, without making any admission of liability with respect to any of the apparent violations cited in this Consent Order, Telmate has agreed for purposes of settlement to pay civil administrative penalties in the amount of \$5,000; and

WHEREAS the provisions of this Consent Order are imposed pursuant to the police powers of the State of New Jersey for the enforcement of the law and regulations and the protection of the public health, safety and welfare, and are not intended to constitute debts which may be limited or discharged in bankruptcy proceedings; and

WHEREAS the parties to this Consent Order have determined that this matter is suitable for resolution upon the consent of the parties and that Telmate and the Commissioner desire to resolve this matter without a hearing or litigation, and for further good cause appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS on this 2/day of 2015

ORDERED AND AGREED as follows:

- 1. Telmate shall undertake the following actions: Obtain proper licensure and comply with all the requirements to conduct its money transmission business in New Jersey pursuant to all the statutes and regulations in reference to the Act. Promptly notify the Enforcement Bureau upon the completion of the application process.
- 2. Telmate shall pay civil administrative penalties in the amount of \$5,000.

Payment shall be made as follows. The amount of said penalties is due in full upon entry into this Consent Order by means of a certified check, bank check or money order <u>made payable to the "Treasurer, State of New Jersey"</u> to be sent to:

3. Telmate consents to the entry of this Consent Order as a final administrative order, and Telmate understands that this final administrative order may be docketed with the Clerk of the Superior Court as provided in the Penalty Enforcement Law, N.J.S.A. 2A:58-10 et seq.
