The claims in this action having been settled and resolved limited to the following parties: Plaintiff-Intervenor, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking & Insurance

("Commissioner"), Defendant Lucy Liu, L.Ac., and Defendant TCM Acupuncture, P.C. ("TCM"):

WHEREAS, Defendant Liu is licensed by the State of New Jersey as an Acupuncturist, and is a "person" and "practitioner" as defined by the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act N.J.S.A 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"); and

WHEREAS, Defendant Liu is the President and Registered Agent of Defendant TCM, which is a New Jersey Professional Corporation and is a "person" as defined by N.J.S.A. 17:33A-3; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner and Defendants Liu, and TCM have reached an amicable agreement resolving the allegations in controversy as raised in the Commissioner's January 6, 2012 Intervenor-Complaint ("Intervenor-Complaint") against Defendants Liu and TCM, and have consented to the entry of the within Stipulation of Settlement; and

WHEREAS, Defendants Liu and TCM agree to testify truthfully and provide full cooperation to the Commissioner in this matter; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5d, Defendants Liu and TCM neither admit nor deny the allegations as stated in the Intervenor-Complaint, but consent to payment of a total of \$541,022.50 ("Settlement Payment") as allocated below; and

pay a sum of \$11,500.00 to the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance, which consists of civil penalties in the amount of \$10,000.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; \$1,000.00 in attorneys' fees, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a \$500.00 statutory surcharge, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and

enter into a Consent Judgment for a sum of \$529,522.50 to the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance, which consists of civil penalties in the amount of \$500,000.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; \$4,522.50 in attorneys' fees, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a \$25,000.00 statutory surcharge, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and

FURTHER STIPULATED AND AGREED, that, upon IT IS Stipulation Defendants' execution of this of Defendant Liu shall remit to the attorney for the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance full the amount of \$11,500.00, by certified check, payment in bank check, money order, made payable official or "Commissioner, New Jersey Department of Banking & Insurance" and sent to:

IT IS FURTHER HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, that if Defendants fail to make any payment, Plaintiff may, upon notice to Defendants, declare the entire balance outstanding to be immediately due and payable. Thereafter, plaintiff may take any action available under the laws of this State to collect the amount outstanding at that time, including post-judgment interest from the date of the judgment, attorneys' fees and other remedies available under the law.

IT IS FURTHER STIPULATED AND AGREED that the penalties of this Stipulation of Settlement are imposed pursuant to the police powers of the State of New Jersey for the enforcement of the law and protection of the public health, safety and welfare, and are not intended to

constitute debts which may be limited or discharged in a bankruptcy proceeding.
