Mutual of Omaha that she had received treatment for spine, neck or back injury within the ten year period preceding the effective date of her application; and

IT IS FURTHER HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED that this conduct constitutes as one violation of N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4, and that any future violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act shall be considered a second violation; and

IS FURTHER HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED that Defendant Patricia Wilson shall pay a total sum of \$2,000.00 to the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. The amount consists of civil penalties in the amount of \$1,500.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; attorneys' fees and costs in the amount of \$425,00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a surcharge of \$75.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and
