

This amount consists of: civil penalties in the amount of \$5,000.00 for one violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 et seq.; attorneys' foos of \$8,871.50, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory surcharge of \$1,000.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory surcharge of \$1,000.00,

IT IS PURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.C.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant Nakisha Jones' driving privileges shall be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this judgment; and
