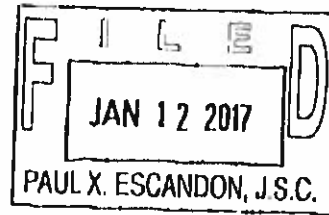

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 12 day of January 2017 entered in the amount of \$13,583.00 against Defendant Tiolympé Larose, and in favor of Plaintiff, Richard J. Badolato, Commissioner of the State of the New Jersey Department of

Banking & Insurance. This amount consists of a \$5,000.00 civil penalty pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b for one (1) violation of the Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 et seq.; attorneys' fees of \$7,583.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant Tiolymp Larose's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date hereof.
