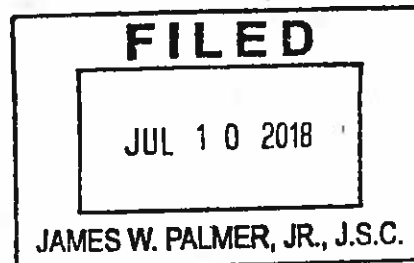



FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 10th day of July 2018, entered in the amount of \$8,380.00 against Defendant and in favor of the Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Acting Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for one violation of

the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; attorneys' fees of \$2,380.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant's driving privileges shall be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date hereof.
