

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 17th day of August entered in the amount of \$8,072.50 against Defendant Maurice Douglas, and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil Insurance. penalties, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b for one violation of the Fraud Act; attorneys' fees of \$2,072.50, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Maurice Douglas's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment.
