



("Fraud Act"); and

**FINAL JUDGMENT** is on this 14th day of September 2018, entered in the amount of **\$94,942.50** against Defendant Jimmy A. Tovar, and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance.<sup>1</sup> This amount consists of \$90,000.00 in civil penalties, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b), for eighteen violations of the Fraud Act; attorneys' fees of \$3,942.50, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Jimmy A. Tovar's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment.

**FURTHER ORDERED** that a copy of this Order be served on all parties of record within seven (7) days of its posting to eCourts.
