**ORDER OF FINAL JUDGEMNT
BY DEFAULT**

Defendant, Robert J. Cook ("Defendant"), having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-entitled action and default having been entered for failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend:

This Court now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act ("Fraud Act"), specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-a(1) and -(2), by presenting or causing to be

presented thirty-three (33) by forging prescriptions and submitting them to a pharmacy as part of, or in support of, a claim for payment or other benefit pursuant to an insurance policy, knowing that the prescriptiopns contained false or misleading information concerning any fact or thing material to the prescription claims.

The Court further finds that Defendant violated the Fraud Act, specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4b, by knowingly assisting, conspiring with, or urging any person or practitioner to violate any of the provisions of the Fraud Act.

The Court further finds that Defendant violated the Fraud Act, specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4c, by, due to assisting, conspiring, or urging of any person, knowingly benefiting, directly or indirectly, from the proceeds derived from a violation of Fraud Act.

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 13th day of November 2018, entered in the amount of \$8,444.49 against Defendant, and in favor of Plaintiff, Commissioner of the State of New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for one (1) violation of the Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$2,384.50 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5; cost of service in the amount of \$59.99 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and \$1,000.00

constituting the statutory surcharge pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date of receipt.
