**ORDER OF FINAL JUDGMENT BY
DEFAULT**

Defendant, Monica Rollins, having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-entitled action and default having been entered for failure to appear, answer or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that Defendant Monica Rollins violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act,

specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4a(1) by presenting written statements as part of, or in support of, claims for payment pursuant to an insurance policy, knowing that the statements contained false or misleading information concerning any fact or thing material to the claims, specifically by submitting five (5) claims to CIGNA for dental services when she knew that no such services had been provided.

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 15th day of February 2019, entered in the amount of \$9,239.99 against Defendant Monica Rollins and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the State of New Jersey Department of Banking & Insurance. This amount consists of: \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for five (5) violations of the Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$3,180.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; \$1,000.00 constituting the surcharge pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and costs of service of process in the amount of \$59.99 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of receipt hereof.
