by presenting an oral statement to Progressive Insurance Company that contained false and misleading information for the purpose of obtaining insurance when denying that the 2011 Honda had been involved in any auto accidents during the time that the insurance policy had lapsed, when in fact it had been involved in an accident;

FINAL JUDGMENT is on the 20th day of February 2019, entered in the amount of \$11,182.00 against Defendant William Dorsey and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for one violation of the Fraud Act pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); attorneys fees of \$5182.00 pursuant N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant William Dorsey's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 5 days of the date of receipt.
