of a claim for payment in violation of N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(1); and (b) knowingly providing false and misleading statements concerning a material fact in an insurance policy application in violation of N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(4)(b); and

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 8th day of March, entered in the amount of \$7,935.00 against Defendant Steven Wick and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of: a \$5,000.00 civil penalty for one violation of the Fraud Act, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); attorneys' fees of \$1,935.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and
