application for automobile insurance and during a claim for benefits; and

entered in the amount of \$8,979.50 against Defendant Dominique Mercahnt and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of: a \$5,000.00 civil penalty for two violations of the Fraud Act, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; attorneys' fees of \$2,979.50, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant Dominique Merchant's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment.
